SECTION V DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

a. Scope

Kenya Reinsurance Corporation hereby invites potential vendors to submit a proposal and quote for upgrading our Local Area Network horizontal cabling at its Headquarters – Reinsurance Plaza 16th Floor and Anniversary Towers – Management Office in Nairobi. The total number of points for Reinsurance Plaza 16th Floor – is 162 Network Points while Anniversary Towers – Management Office is 16 Points.

The following will entail the scope of works to be carried out: -

- 1. The Contractor will be responsible for the supply of all materials and components necessary to complete the installation of the structured cabling system.
- 2. The contractor will be responsible for pulling, terminating, and testing all circuits installed and each cable shall be assigned a unique cable number.
- 3. The primary media for horizontal cabling will be 4-pair Unshielded Twisted Pair (UTP) in accordance with International Structured Cabling System designs. Each subsystem will be implemented using category 6 compliant components and be deployed according to ANSI/TIA/EIA-568-B and ISO/IEC 11801 standards. Each designated network interface will have capacity to support Gigabit Ethernet speed.
- 4. The horizontal cabling will include outlets and consolidation or transition points, connectors, and patch cords that compose horizontal cross-connect. The cables will be routed in existing wall trunking and terminated on patch panels and at data outlets. Patch panels must be equipped with RJ45 contacts of category 6 sockets with a capacity of 24 and must be rack mountable. Where cables cannot be run in the building's trunkings within the walls or floor, surface pathways using metal trunkings will be installed.
- 5. The contractor shall test the newly terminated network points with a fluke meter to validate performance, Cable Length etc. All results shall then be availed as documented evidence.
- 6. The contractor will be required to comply with the manufacturers recommended installation practices.

NOTE: Bidders will be required to carry out an independent site survey only on the following date and time: 7TH April 2021 at 09:30 AM Reinsurance Plaza and 7th April 2021 at 12:00 PM - Anniversary Towers.
